Moreira Chonguiça is a jazz musician, composer, producer, ethnomusicologist and entrepreneur from Mozambique.

Chonguiça has several award-winning albums. His albums include 'The Moreira Project Vol 1: The Journey' (2005), 'The Moreira Project Vol 2: Citizen of the World' (2008), 'Khanimambo: Moreira Chonguiça salutes the Legends of Mozambique' (2011), 'MP Reloaded' (2013), 'Sensasons' (2014) and 'M & M: Moreira Chonguiça & Manu Dibango' (2017).

He has produced music for a number of African artists and written music for movies and documentaries.

Chonguiça has received a number of acolades in Mozambique over the years, including appointment to the advisory committee for the Mozambican Minister of Culture and being the only individual recipient of the 'Made in Mozambique' seal.

He was awarded the Order of Merit for his contribution to Mozambican jazz by the president of Portugal, Marcelo Rebelo de Sousa and most recently in 2018, he was appointed as the Mozambican representative to the Ashinaga Initiative in Japan.

In 2019 he was invited by UNESCO to attend the International Jazz Day celebrations in Addis Ababa. In 2020 Chonguiça was invited to partake in the Global International Jazz Day concert on 30 April in Cape Town that was cancelled due to Covid-19.
